Criteria for Selection

1. Five (5) subjects passed at **grade one** or **grade two** in CSEC (or equivalent grades in recognized examinations).
2. Must have a **grade one** or **grade two** in the subjects selected for study in sixth form. Some subjects require a grade one and will not accept students with grade two.
3. **Grade one** or **two** in English A and Mathematics.
4. Excellent attendance and punctuality records.
5. Excellent discipline and decorum.
6. Students who meet the minimum selection criteria may be offered a place depending on the availability of space.

CAPE UNIT 2 Options

All unit 1 subjects are also offered in unit 2 in upper six. Students must pass Unit 1 of the subject in order to matriculate into Unit 2.

Admission for Faculties

New admissions to Upper Six must pass unit 1 with grades **1, 2 or 3**. Grades 4 and 5 will not be accepted for new admissions to Upper Six.

Caribbean Studies is normally offered in Upper Six. A passing grade in Communication Studies is a prerequisite for matriculation into Caribbean Studies.

Assets

Subjects listed as assets are not required but an exposure to these subjects will help in the course of study at CAPE. Evidence of exposure to these subjects may also have a favourable bearing on the selection process.

Spanish

External students must have a GRADE 1 in CXC CSEC Spanish. All external students are required to pass an admission interview in Spanish before being accepted. Students must have passed CSEC English B.

Students will not be accepted with subject equivalent from other examination bodies.
